

Fresh peaches are picked firm-ripe in order to transport without bruising.

Do not refrigerate firm peaches unless you prefer to eat them firm.

Soften firm peaches by spreading the peaches a few inches apart on a flat cloth with stems down and tips up for about 2 days at room temperature.

Soft peaches are good for about 3 days at room temperature or about 1 week in the refrigerator.

Slice and freeze soft peaches to maintain peach flavor for months.

HANDLING PECANS

Freeze shelled pecans in an airtight bag for maximum shelf life.

Pecans are good for a few weeks at room temperature or for several months in a refrigerator, but frozen pecans will stay fresh for up to 2 years!



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
